

Summer Fair

Mufti Day

We will be holding a mufti day on Tuesday 20th June. Your child can wear mufti clothes in exchange for an item for our tombola as follows:

Reception and Year 1: Sweets (bags or tubs of sweets)

Year 2: Smellies (for example - bubble bath, bath bomb, soap, scented oils)

Year 3: Non-perishable food, all must be well within their sell-by date (for example biscuits, tinned food, pasta etc)

Year 4, 5 and 6: Bottles of drink (for example - alcohol, fizzy, fruit juice, squash). If you are bringing in alcohol, please could you give it to either the adults on the doors or the school office.

Following on from our amazing Coronation Bake Off where we saw some incredible bakes, we will be holding another cake stall at the Summer Fair. If you would like to donate a cake, please could you bring it in on Friday 23rd June in the morning.

The inflatable assault course will also be available during the summer fair times for the same price though this will be cash only. Please note, you may need to queue for this.

<u>Parent Champion for SEND</u> – <u>Confidential</u> monthly <u>support</u> and advice for families

As a school we want to play a role in improving SEND services for our children. We now have an opportunity to provide a confidential space here in school for families of children with SEND through a new Parent Champion project delivered and funded by SENDiass4BCP and Parent Carers Together.

Each month a dedicated Parent Champion will hold one session to support families in navigating appropriate local and national services and networks to meet the needs of their children. Your child does not have to be on the SEND register at school to be able to access the support. Time slots will be allocated to individual families on a first come first served basis and are held in confidence during the school day.

<u>Our next session is on Tuesday 27th June</u>, to enable us to plan ahead for these sessions we are asking parent/carers to book onto a session by emailing <u>parent2parent@elm-academy.org.uk</u>.

If you are experiencing difficulties and are unsure where to access the support and resources you need please do get in touch and confirm your interest in writing. The role of the Parent Champion is to listen and to share knowledge of the services and the networks in your local community that may be of help to you.

This is a valuable resource we are so pleased to be part of. Together we can improve services and support for families across Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole.

Holiday Activities and food programme (HAF)

School holidays can be difficult for families with increased costs for food and childcare.

The Department for Education funded holiday activities and food programme (HAF) provides free holiday activity places for children a young people in receipt of benefits-based free school meals, from reception year to age 16.

A meal is also provided whilst the child or young person is at the activity. Additionally, the programme provides nutritional education for children and their families and signposting to other support services for families.

HAF funded activities are available during the easter, summer and christmas holidays. Half terms are not included.
