What an exciting 2 weeks. I have managed to spend some time in with the new Reception class and how well they have all settled in.

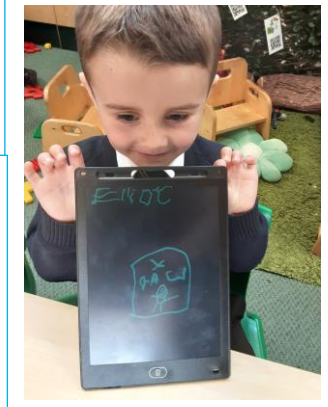
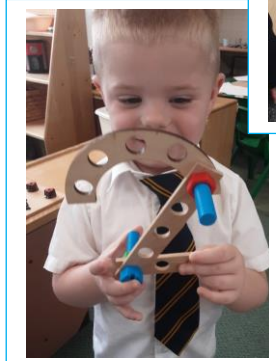
Year 4 have been doing brilliantly at swimming with many already swimming without any aids. We have also had compliments from the public about their behaviour. Well done Year 4!

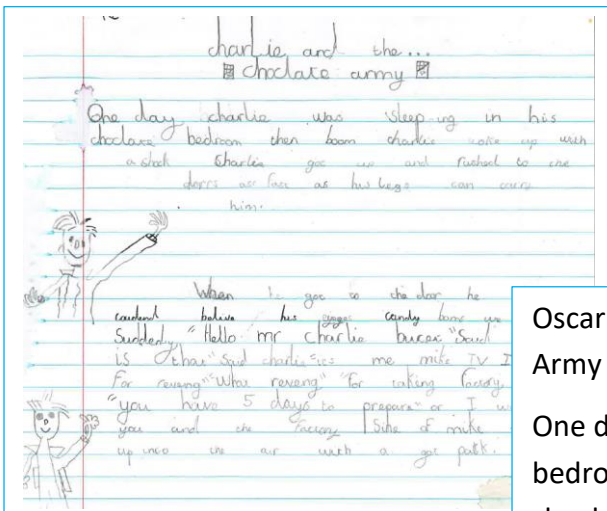
Elms celebrates our Pupils

Parent Champion for SEND – Confidential monthly support and advice for families

As a school we want to play a role in improving SEND services for our children. We now have an opportunity to provide a confidential space here in school for families of children with SEND through a new Parent Champion project delivered and funded by SENDiass4BCP and Parent Carers Together.

Each month a dedicated Parent Champion will hold one session to support families in navigating appropriate local and national services and networks to meet the needs of their children. Your child does not have to be on the SEND register at school to be able to access the support. Time slots will be allocated to individual families on a first come first served basis and are held in confidence during the school day.

Our next Parent Champion sessions will take place on Tuesday 17th October 2023
